

Much of the planting work was undertaken by over 40 local volunteers amounting to a total of at least 166 days. Planting consisted of:

- 30 fruit and nut trees
- 70 square metres of Miyawaki Forest
- about 500 hedging plants
- approximately 3000 bulbs
- grass and wild flower seed

The overall costs of the project, were:
