ACTIVITIES TO REPORT	<p>26 June Visit by Landulph School to Duchess Green</p> <p>As part of Landulph Orchard Green's Community Levelling Up grant (Y4 CAP3 004), classes 1 and 2 of Landulph School (about 44 children) accompanied by members of staff and two governors undertook a Nature Treasure Hunt. Eight members of the community undertook to help the children undertake activities at 6 points in Duchess Green and 2 points in Duke Orchard. The visit was enjoyed by all involved - dubbed by one child the second best school visit after the Eden Project. Materials for this event were provided by Tamar Valley Centre so total cost was £11.17.</p> <p>The Treasure Hunt was so successful that Landulph Climate Group would like to provide a pack so that children and adults visiting Landulph can enjoy their own Nature Treasure Hunt (see costs below).</p> <p>Cornwall Wildlife Trust has provided material on Wildlife Gardening for the Open Garden planned for 3 August (4 - 6pm) and the garden owner has kindly offered to provide drinks and nibbles so there will be no cost associated with this event.</p>
