TITLE	Searl Family Memorial Field Working Group Update

ACTIVITIES TO REPORT	<p>The group met in mid-July to discuss the suggestions for use of the field. Particularly discussing the suggestions which had the most interest: allotments, dog walking, nature reserve and solar energy. The parishioners who expressed particular interest in these suggestions will be contacted and asked if they could develop their ideas further; how the proposal would be managed and funded; in particular to ensure that the usage of the field is financially self-supporting going forward. Grants might be available; but a detailed plan will need to be drawn up first. We acknowledge that this will take some time.</p> <p>In the interim, we need to manage the site. We need a pedestrian gate and to get the grass cut and taken away. This will be investigated. Note that if the site is used for dog running and there is dog poo in the grass then we will not be able to get the grass cut and taken by a farmer.</p> <p>The electricity bill is £18.67 per month standing charge. We are investigating if we can cease the supply contract without penalty. Then reconnect when we need it later.</p> <p>Water is costing us £13.50 per quarter. We are going have another attempt to find the source of the leak. No information obtained yet on the exact route of the supply pipe.</p> <p>There is no sign of Callington removing their remaining items from the grounds. The Clerk has contacted them.</p>
