	a) Install a 3rd wire between poles 45SCEF3 and 45SCEG8 (approximately 1150 metres) -Add a lazy leg pole at 45SCEG8 to support new 3 phase transformer -Relocate pole 45SCE7 approximately 15 metres further south from the tower line. This is to balance the span lengths either side of that pole Install a new mid span pole to be numbered 45SCEG1. This is required to maintain statutory ground clearance and shorten the existing span lengthsReconfigure pole 45SCEF8 and add one extra stay to act as an out of balance stay to keep pole supported and uprightReplace 45SCEF2, 45SCEF3, 45SCEF4, 45SCEF5, 45SCEF6 & condition assess all other poles and if necessary change the poles whilst carrying out the 3rd wire works.
