### **Parish Clerk Vacancy**

### **Filming in Cargreen**

On 15 August, there will be one day of filming in and around The Boathouse on Slipway Quay for the BBC series 'Beyond Paradise'. The film company have agreed with the Landulph Memorial Hall and the Parish Council to use the Memorial Hall for their parking to minimise the amount of traffic up and down Fore Street. On 15 August, the coffee morning at LMH has been cancelled and there will be times when it is not possible to use the Slipway Quay carpark for turning. Local residents have received a letter from Red Planet Pictures with more details. As with previous filming in the Parish, this should be an interesting experience.

As part of the trial to provide more opportunities for those with limited access to public transport, Saltash Red Bus is running a bus from Cargreen to Tavistock on Saturday, 16 August leaving Cargreen at 10:30. ## **Dog Fouling**

Recently there have been a number of complaints about dog fouling in the Parish. Apart from dog fouling being unpleasant, Cornwall Council have introduced a Dog Fouling Public Public Spaces Protection Order which makes it an offence to fail to clear up properly after your dog on any land in Cornwall that the public has access to. If you witness persistent fouling you can report this to Cornwall Council.

## **What to do if you need help**

During COVID a Volunteer Group was set up on WhatsApp to provide help to residents who could not easily get help with problems outside of the scope of the emergency services). This volunteer group still exists and was used last week when a resident could not get a taxi to take them to the minor injuries unit at Liskeard.
