Work has now started on the groundworks funded by the Community Levelling Up Programme to enhance accessibility and provide regular local events in both Duke Orchard and Duchess Green. Improvements will include renovating an old track to create a turning and drop-off area at Duchess Green and upgrading paths using recycled hardcore to allow easier access for people with disabilities and families with young children. Both fields will remain open during the works but please take care and do not allow children to play on equipment.
