A number of options are being discussed. £443.41 left in Earmarked Reserve.</p> <p>Y4CAP3 Community Levelling Up: The final claim for £17,384.23 has been submitted and all work is complete.</p> <p>Landulph Orchard Green Earmarked Reserve: £508.60 (+£443.41)</p> <p>Landulph Orchard Green General Fund: £150.75, £500 allocated for 2026/27 financial year.</p> <p>Activities</p> <p>Working Group Meeting - 3 February 2026</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Wassail was a great success with about 40 people attending including several families with children who had a great time exploring Duchess Green. - Following events planned: LOG celebration and thank you on 21 February at Yacht Club (18:30 - 21:30), Fruit Freedom Day for trees in Duke Orchard on 22 February (14:00 - 16:00), Daffodil Day in Duchess Green on 28 March to include work on hedging (14:00 - 16:00) and tea at 16:00. - Discussed hedge cutting options and agreed to get the hedge at bottom of Duke Orchard cut by hand, run a Cornish hedge laying course for volunteers on road side hedge in Duke Orchard and seek quotes for cutting the laurels in Duchess Green in the autumn. - Agreed to cover surface of boardwalk bridge with used tree mesh guards as it has become slippery. - Agreed to continue with adhoc working parties to tackle specific jobs - Agreed Working Group to continue to meet monthly with existing membership. <p>Working parties - 7-8 February</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Fallen branches cleared - Boardwalk bridge covered with mesh - Cowl on overflow pipe replaced and steps cut - Door stops for woo woo loos fitted
