2. Messages from the Parish Council

Flood In Coombe Lane

There is concern about the flood in Coombe Lane between Cargreen Yacht Club and a resident's drive entrance. The Parish Council has reported it over several months as it is our Emergency Route out of Cargreen and Cornwall Highways are aware. They have inspected, drained once but discovered roots have impacted the underground drain which needs a specialist team and equipment to resolve. All this, in record all time rain levels in Cornwall for this time of year. We have a formal deadline of 16th Feb 26 for a report on what will be done with a timeline. This will be presented at our parish council meeting that evening. In the meantime please proceed with care.

Thank you to those who submitted a response to the government consultation on future ready fuels including HVO. Over 16,000 responses were received (normal consultations get about 1,000 responses) with 20% coming from Cornwall. We would like to write to our local MP to stress the importance of choice for those householders with oil fired boilers. Please reply to this email if you would like your name added to the email.

This year's Big Plastic Count is from 9 to 15 March. This is an annual event to collect real data on household plastic waste. All you need to do is count the plastic you throw away or recycle in the week and submit it online (just reply if you would like help with submitting the data).
