Planned A38 Overnight Closure Details

Planned night works will commence on Monday 20th April and will take place over four consecutive nights. During this period, there will be a full closure of the A38 at Stoketon Cross, with clearly signed diversion routes in place. The closures will be in effect each night from 8:00pm to 5:00am. These works are necessary to facilitate the installation of new services ducting across the A38, which requires excavation of the existing carriageway. [Diversion details](#).

New Cornwall Recycling Options

For Tetra Pak-style cartons for milk, juice, soups and more, just give your cartons a rinse, squash and put them in your red recycling bag. For soft plastics, squash all your plastic bags, film lids and wrappers into either an either a bread bag, vegetable or fruit bag, or carrier bag to stop it from blowing away. Tie it up and put it in your red recycling bag.

Results of Cornwall Council Parking Consultation
