ACTIVITIES TO REPORT	Update on Finances Landulph Orchard Green Earmarked Reserve: £435.83 Landulph Orchard Green General Fund: £500 allocated for 2026/27 financial year but approx. £100 committed for printing and renewal of data contract for Solar router. Tamar Valley NL have approved the costing for an accessibility grant for about £7000 – payment to be reimbursement of costs. This is to open up the bottom gate in Duke Orchard and provide an accessible path and gate from the verge hard standing up to the current path. This will benefit both those with walking difficulties and children. Meeting 13 July 2026 • Thanks were given to Gwen Morris who has left the Working Group but will continue to work as a Logger (including monthly monitoring). • Agreed to approach additional people for the Working Group • Reviewed LOG pages on landulph.org and agreed to amendments. • Community Chest project is nearly complete with installation of Weather Station, wildlife camera sign and Youtube for wildlife camera videos. • Both Landulph Festival community event (about 200 people attended including the Rock Choir) and LCG Landulph School event (55 children and 5 members of staff attended) were well received and enjoyed by volunteers. The new turning area worked well for the minibuses used to minimise traffic down Church Lane. Landulph Festival collected donations on entry and will donate to the LOG ER. • Official position of organisations using Duke Orchard or Duchess Green was discussed. Agreed that it is not possible for us to sublet either field because of the position with the Duchy, so for any event the fields need to remain open to all local people. The Parish Council insurers have confirmed: <i>'You would be covered for events with up to 2000 attendees at any one time without the need for additional premium again with risk assessments in place, following any relevant guidelines and 3rd parties such as caterers had their own PL to the same level of indemnity.'</i> • Maintenance priorities were discussed for next volunteer day. Agreed that we may have the necessary volunteer expertise to complete the hedge laying in Duke Orchard in the autumn without further expense.
