| ACTIVITIES TO REPORT | <p>The order has been placed for the fencing materials, in the sum of £15,228 plus VAT. Other materials have been purchased, in the sum of £307.79 to date. The combined cost is expected to be £21k leaving £1k in the earmarked reserve.</p> <p>David Ford has prepared an estimate for the cost of repairing the tractor. This is £645 for materials with labour volunteers. The cost of a new tractor would be £3,500. It was last overhauled in 2017 so the last major overhaul lasted 9 years.</p> <p>A parishioner commented that the hedge adjacent to the playground was overgrown. We have asked the grass cutting contractor to cut back the overhanging brambles and branches to make the path way clear.</p> |
