At last, we have managed to finally terminate the Octopus contract with any cost to the parish. Well done Karen. 3. A parishioner contacted the council enquiring about a dog running area and sighted the Hatt playing field where dogs are allowed off the leash. Cllr Gawith visited the Hatt playing area, and contacted the Clerk of Botus Fleming who said that there had been some issues with dog fouling but not much. However, we have also spoken to the contractor who cuts their grass who advised that he has to clear a fair amount of dog fouling and the football pitch does need to be cleared before play. This is even though they have dog bins and poo bags available. He doesn't think the problem comes from residents. The cost of keeping the field cut is about £5k. Their field is 2.25 acres, which is smaller than our 3-acre field. 4. The working group is meeting on the 16th to agree a way forward.
