Working Group on Our Priorities

The Parish Council is looking for help developing a Landulph Neighbourhood Priority Statement to express the community's priorities for future development and services. It will be used to inform Cornwall Council's Local Plan. [More details](#)

Sammy Sands Slipway Sign

As part of the Marine Recreation Mitigation and Management Scheme for the Plymouth Sound and Estuaries Marine Protected Area, Landulph has been given a slipway panel. This replaces the very old and tired sign on Sammy Sands. In particular, the sign contains some useful emergency contact numbers.

Pilot for an additional bus

Landulph is working with Saltash Red Bus to investigate an additional bus from Cargreen to Saltash and return each weekday afternoon. The bus would allow adults to make a quick trip into Saltash and school children to return home. There will be a trial bus on Monday, August 17 leaving Cargreen at 15:45 and returning to a discussion with tea & biscuits on the quay at about 17:00. All welcome. Hosepipe Restriction

A temporary restriction on hosepipe use came into effect from 00.01 on Saturday 8 August. Hosepipes should not be used for watering gardens, washing cars, patios, hot tubs or filling swimming and paddling pools. [More details](#)
